The 'Cremation Only' Way

The 'Cremation Only' Way involves taking your loved one to a crematorium of our choice. Only the Funeral Service staff are permitted to be in attendance.

Who may consider this option?

- A loved one who has requested that no funeral service is to take place for them
- A family who intend to hold a memorial service for their loved one at a later date
- Those who do not wish to follow the tradition of having a funeral service
- A family who wish to do something personal to them as a family group on a different day
- A family who are looking at the least expensive option

What's included?

- Make the necessary arrangements for cremation at a time specified by ourselves
- Collect deceased from place of death between 8am and 5pm, Monday to Friday
- Care of deceased for up to 14 days
- Alternative vehicle to a Hearse to go direct to the Crematorium
- Simple cremation coffin of our choice
- Provision of 2 bearers
- Crematorium Fee (No service)
- Cremated remains will be scattered in the Garden of Remembrance at the Crematorium where the cremation took place

- A family on a very low income
- A family who do not wish to attend the crematorium but would like to visit their loved one in the chapel of rest
- A family of up to 8 people who would like to hold a small service in our chapel of rest

What's included?

- Arrange all aspects of the family gathering (maximum 8 people) in our Totnes Chapel at a time and date specified by ourselves
- Collect deceased from place of death between 8am-5pm, Mon-Fri
- Care of deceased
- Alternative vehicle to a Hearse to go direct to the Crematorium
- Simple cremation coffin of our choice
- Crematorium Fee (No service)
- Religious Minister or Celebrant
- One viewing of your loved one who will be dressed in a gown of our choice
- The cremated remains will be scattered in the Garden of Remembrance at the Crematorium where the cremation took place

- Religious Minister or Celebrant
- Cremated remains will be scattered in the Garden of Remembrance at the Crematorium where the cremation took place
